Young Adults need Christ and His Church, and the Church needs young adults. This concern was a consistent theme of the Diocesan Synod and the Fifth National Encuentro process. As a response, the Office of Ethnic Ministry is facilitating a Leadership Workshop for Hispanic/Latino Young Adults ages 18-30. The workshop will offer young people the opportunity to reflect on their call to be missionary disciples in the current reality. We will respond to the question "What kind of leadership is the Church and the world waiting for?" We will reflect on the current reality of Hispanic/Latino young adults - population (numbers, ages, etc.), participation in the Church (religion (faith tradition), spirituality, etc.).
 Facilitator: Armando Cervantes. Armando is a first-generation Mexican-American, he has two Master Degrees in Business Administration and Pastoral Theology and has served in leadership on various local, regional and national boards and organizations. He has over 20 years of professional experience in various ministries serving all age groups in Catholic Dioceses and Non-Profits. Armando serves nationally and internationally as a coach, consultant, advocate, trainer, speaker, strategist and nonprofit professional focusing on areas of strategy, vision, planning, stewardship, social media, youth and young adult engagement and intercultural competencies. Currently he is the Director of Youth & Young Adult Ministry for the Diocese of Orange, sits on the Board of Directors for ODB Films, is a Ministry Coach for Parish Success Group and serves as an Associate for Church Media Solution. He and his wife currently live in the City of Orange in sunny southern California. Armando is actively involved at the regional and national level with the National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry (NFCYM) and The National Network of Pastoral Juvenil Hispana (La Red).
