not religious."



When a family is in harmony, all with the same mind, working
together for the same goal, it is a blessing to be part of that
oneness. They are different people but they think and act as one
family. That is a great image for the Trinity! You have different
persons but they are completely one in mind and action. As we
celebrate the Trinity, maybe we can pray for our families to become a
better image of the Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit with one mind
acting together as one. We should also pray for our parishes and dioceses
to have the same mind, and will, choosing to work together for the common
good. This means to love the world like God does. "God so loved the world
that he gave his only Son..." The Second Person of the Trinity came forth
from the heavenly realm to give everything for us, and since these three
are one, both the Father and the Holy Spirit were wounded in the Son's
wounds. Paul's image of Body of Christ is instructive. Though the body has
many parts, all parts though many are one. You cannot hurt the hand, the
side, or the feet without the whole body feeling it. It is that way with God
and should be that way with us. St. Paul writes in the second reading,
"Brothers and sisters, rejoice. Mend your ways, encourage one another,
agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will
be with you." (2 Cor 13:11). God will be with us if we live like the Trinity,
three persons yet, at peace, one in mind, heart and action.
