In the gospel this weekend Jesus says, "My Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does, he prunes so that it bears more fruit." There are many fruits that Christians can produce, but we have 12 of which the Catechism speaks, nine of these fruits are named in Galatians 5:22-23. One of these fruits is faithfulness. For example some people have been faithfully praying three Hail Marys after Mass since the time of Fr. Hilden. One story I was told was that when Fr. Jeffrey went off to the missions in Peru, Fr. Hilden asked the people to say 3 Hail Marys for him. A number of people have that practice as part of their spirituality. Our Pastoral Council recently discussed this practice. They thought that we should name a new intention and re-invite people into this practice. After discussion it was agreed that we should ask all of you to say three Hail Marys after each Mass for the following intention: "That people return to their Catholic Faith." I would go further and ask you to say these prayers everyday for that particular intention. There are many reasons why people wander away from their faith. Sometimes it is because of other's sins, especially leaders. The Devil loves it when he can point out sins and get more people to abandon Jesus and his Sacraments. That is a win, win situation for the evil one, and it is lose, loose situation for the Kingdom of God. St. Augustine says that the Father has the power to re-graft the branches that have been cut off from the True Vine, Jesus. That is why on the day of the Resurrection Jesus comes to them and wishes peace to his disciples then he breathed on them the Holy Spirit and said if you forgive sins they are forgiven. We can counter all sin with prayer and Mary is a great advocate so I invite you to say three Hail Marys after each Mass and everyday that people return to their Catholic Faith, to return to the True Vine and the Church He established.
