Jesus' relatives come "to seize him for they said, 'He is out of his mind.'" The scribes are saying "he is possessed by Beelzebul". From every side Jesus is "getting it." Mark's Gospel is the earliest gospel and the Christians are not accepted by their families and are being persecuted just as Jesus seems to be misunderstood by his family and not accepted by the leading Jewish officials. Jesus points out, "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." It is the same with us. We can find family and oneness with those who do God's will. There has to be a willingness to enter into the solitude. Jesus was willing to stay with his God and his mission though all seemed against him. I remember when thoughts first came to me of being a priest when I was young. I rejected the idea because what I saw was a solitary life. It seemed that people did not really relate to the priest that I knew in any significant manner. I may have been wrong but that is the way I perceived it. What probably amplified that feeling was the priest was unmarried like Jesus and look what happened to him. I thought I could just blend in and be a lukewarm Christian like I perceived most of the parishioners of my home parish (not that they were). The passage from Revelations really hit me in the face one day when some people pointed out: "Oh how I wish you were either hot or cold, but because you are lukewarm, I will spew you out of my mouth," Rev 3:15-16. Jesus was willing to risk being rejected and thought he was "out of his mind" to stay true to his Father's calling. Are we willing to be a follower of Jesus like that? "Though none go with me still I will follow" the old song says. Can we sing it and mean it?
