Elijah, in the first reading was fleeing from Queen Jezebel who has promised that she will kill him. He is totally exhausted when he comes to a "broom tree". He wants only to die, but God feeds him a hearth cake by the hand of an angel and it gives him drink twice: "Strengthened by that food, he walked forty days and forty nights to the mountain of God, Horeb." Have you heard of the song Panis Angelicus? It is latin for "bread of angels". Of course this is referring to the Eucharist. Elijah received some amazing food from the angel to walk forty days and forty nights to the mountain of God, Horeb. It was food for a journey. The Eucharist is called food for the Journey, but it generally does not give us the power to walk long distances in this world. It is food for the most amazing journey any human can make: to move from this world to a whole new world of glory. St. Paul says we are moving from "glory to glory" (2 Cor 3:18). The glorified body and blood of Christ is what we are receiving under the forms of bread and wine to make this new kind of journey. It is a kind of journey that is foreign to this world's way of thinking. In this world we move from place to place. In the Eucharistic journey, we move from many forms of the deadly sins. Pride which often masquerades as something healthy. People admire someone who can shout, "I did it my way!". We move from "my way" to docility to God's will. As Mary said at the Annunciation, "Let it be done to me as you say". Or as Jesus said to the Father in the garden, "Not as I will but as you will." In our area of the world, the sin of greed can be very much admired. He is very industrious, a good business man with acumen... But where is the Spirit's fruit of generosity in proportion to what he has received? Being glorified means producing all the fruits of the Spirit. Now that is a journey that is impossible for sinners without God's grace. We need the Bread of Life, the glorified Body of Christ.
