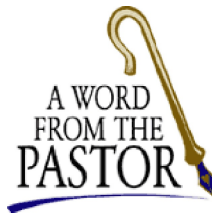

My time in Haiti and Mexico was enjoyable and challenging, but it is always good to be back home even if it is storming and cold. This is where I feel God has called me to be as your pastor. My time of travel was important because it is really vital to stay connected to our Twin Parish in Haiti and for me to work on my Spanish, since I am still the coordinator of Hispanic Ministries for the our Diocese. Fr. Wilfranc, Pastor of our Twin Parish in Haiti, sends his greetings to all the parishioners of St. Johns. He promises to pray for us and we will for him. He expressed many times his gratefulness for our continued support. The process to build the school in Haiti is continuing. I signed the documents with Partners in Progress after Bishop Folda gave permission for the release of funds. The Bishop of Hinche, Haiti, officially gave Fr. Wilfranc permission to build this school. Partners in Progress is a non-profit organization who is over seeing the building of the school. It will be made out of Earth Block which is essentially Adobe materials, a combination of sand, clay, and sprinkled cement. It brings Adobe building into the modern era by pressing the bricks with machines. There are many advantages: it is fire proof, sound proof, worms or termites do not eat it, protects from bullets, and a great insulator that keeps the inside of the building cooler in the heat of the day. It also breathes, in other words, it allows moisture to pass through it so mold does not develop. We are building this school to protect children in earthquakes and withstand hurricane winds. Thank you for being part of this amazing work.

My time in Mexico with Fr. Scott McDermott was inspiring as in the past. The gospel for this weekend is perfect for his amazing parish, St. Theresa of Avila. In the Gospel after they listened and obeyed Jesus' words, they caught so many fish their nets were tearing. Peter became aware of his sinfulness, which often happens when people draw close to Jesus, and he tells Jesus to leave him because he is sinful. Jesus says, "Do not be afraid, from now on you will be catching men." That is what the parish of Saint Theresa of Avila does in Mexico where drug cartels have so much influence. In the midst of the darkness there is weekend after weekend of "Encuentros" or encounters with Jesus. There is about 42 a year for young people and many encounters for married people. They all have one goal: for people to encounter the life giving force who is Jesus. We at St John the Evangelist have the same goal. This weekend we are beginning our God's Gift campaign once again. We work with our Bishop to help people encounter Jesus throughout the eastern half of North Dakota. May we always be faithful to our Patron Saint John who has evangelized many through the ages by his life and writing. He helped many people to encounter Jesus.
