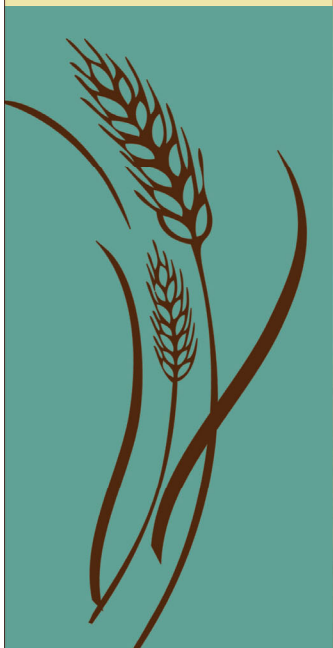

16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**THE MERCY, POWER, AND LOVE OF GOD**

The first reading today, from the book of Wisdom, makes its point over and over, at least five times in five verses! God is mighty, but lenient to all. God's power is shown in kindness and clemency, not in harshness and condemnation, and those who govern God's people must govern in the same way, with kindness. This loving kindness and gentleness is not contrary to God's might, but is a direct result of God's primacy over all. Who are we, then, to judge what is in the hearts of our fellow Christians and all people, when God commands justice with love and clemency?

Likewise, the Holy Spirit makes up for our ignorance of what we need, speaking in a language we do not yet understand. But God knows our needs before we do, understands the intercessions of the Spirit, and helps us in our weakness. This is our hope: God's mercy, power, and love.

**97TH ANNIVERSARY
OF SAN ROCCO CELEBRATION IN CHICAGO**

On Sunday, August 13, the solemn Mass will be celebrated at St. Therese Church at 10:30 a.m. followed by the annual procession. The celebration will end at 5 p.m. with benediction.

**ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY (VELIKA GOSPA)
AT ST. JEROME**

The feast of the Assumption of Our Lady (Velika Gospa in Croatian) will be celebrated soon for the 112th time at St. Jerome Parish. Novena will start on Sunday, August 6 with Masses at 7 p.m. each day celebrated by a different priest. On Sunday, August 6, there will be Rizot (Croatian style rice) and homemade bread offered from 4 to 9 p.m. On Saturday, August 12, there will be a bake sale (apple strudel, povitica-walnut roll and much more) from 5:30 to 9 p.m.

On Tuesday, August 15, Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m., 9 a.m., 12 noon (after the procession), and at 7 p.m. (youth/young adults Mass). Procession will start at 10 a.m. going through the neighborhood and ending at the church with a solemn Mass at noon. Throughout the day there will be dishes, beverages, music, games and much more for everyone. The evening will conclude with a firework display and a \$20,000 raffle at 11 p.m.
