MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Join me in praising God: At the 9:30 Eucharist last Sunday we baptized **Jaylen Sebastian Manzano**, infant son of **Jennifer** and **Juan**. I encourage you to pray a novena to the Holy Spirit during the nine days between what we used to call Ascension Thursday and the Solemnity of Pentecost, this year May 11-19. Here is a simple prayer schedule for this novena: Day 1 (Friday): Read chapter 1 of the Acts of the Apostles; Day 2-8: read one of the seven sections of Psalm 104 with the antiphon (verse 30) before and after the section - **Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.**; Day 9 (Saturday): Read chapter 2 of the Acts of the Apostles/*Te animo a orar una novena al Espíritu Santo durante los nueve días, entre lo que solíamos llamar el Jueves de la Ascensión y la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, este año del 11 al 19 de mayo. A continuación puedes ver un horario de oración simple para esta novena: Día 1: Lee el capítulo 1 de los Hechos de los Apóstoles; Día 2-8: lee una de las siete secciones del Salmo 104 con la antífona (versículo 30) antes y después de la sección: Envía tu Espíritu y renueva la faz de la tierra. Día 9: Lee el capítulo 2 de los Hechos de los Apóstoles.*
