* Did you also know that learning a new language can boost your memory, improve thinking skills and fight the effects of aging on your brain?

* Have you heard that uniting our voices in song is one of the highest forms of praise?

Beginning this Sunday, October 14th, we will have a new opportunity to do all of the above through singing bilingual music (English and Spanish) on the second Sunday of each month. The way this will work is that all songs will be in both languages so that if you are not already bilingual you can still participate and understand what we are singing. Believe it or not, this presents us with a tri-fold opportunity for service.

1) You can serve those trying to learn your native tongue by singing with confidence so that those who are learning the language can hear how the words are supposed to sound.

2) We can build community by joining our voices in praise of God.

3) You can challenge your brain in the areas of music and language which just might be a lasting gift to yourself and your loved ones.
