I invite you to gather on **Friday, November 2nd, All Souls Day (Día de los Muertos/Day of the Dead)** as many did last year after the Evening Prayer and the blessings at the graves at Sacred Heart Cemetery for some food, drinks, and conversation with those who are paying their respects for the dead. This is a simple version of what is done in Mexico. I invite us to do just that: bring simple sandwiches and finger foods – nothing that needs forks or spoons; drinks, cups and napkins will be provided. We'll celebrate the evening with those who have gone before us. As far as I can tell there is no football game on Friday, as the Bulldogs have an open night.

THE WRAP CAMPAIGN (White Ribbon Against Pornography) is held each year at the end of October. Norma Norris of Butler, Pa., began the White Ribbon Week in 1987 after hearing a sermon against pornography delivered by her parish priest, Msg. Francis Glenn. Norma used a simple white ribbon as a symbol of decency to inform the public of the harm done by exposure to pornography. The National center on Sexual Exploitation has expanded the campaign to include human trafficking and the physical abuse of women and children.

In support of this campaign, Catholic Daughters Court Sacred Heart of Mother Teresa #2570, Flatonia, will hand out white ribbons and a prayer after Mass today. We hope you will wear the ribbon and join us in prayer this week as we work to end the harm caused by pornography.
