## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

SSCM parishioners: February 14, our patronal feast day for Saints Cyril and Methodius, is this Thursday. We celebrate this feast day as a solemnity with Eucharist at 6:00 PM followed by a catered meal. If you haven't come to the meal before, please join us; just let the office or Edna Mae Psencik know that you are coming. If you've usually attended, no need to contact anyone; we've got you counted. But if you've usually attended and can't make it this year, please let the office or Edna Mae know.

Last Wednesday evening the second, fourth, and sixth grades of CCF-Youth began in Sacred Heart Church with the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens for Alexa Rodríguez, daughter of Raymon Rodríguez. I presided at this first step in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Alexa is in the third grade (attending the second for CCF) and did an outstanding job in professing her desire to continue to follow Jesus Christ and become a baptized Christian. Brenda Romero, sixth grade catechist, and Nicki Trejo, fourth grade catechist aide, were sponsors for Alexa; Raymon had to work. The CCF-Youth children and other catechists and catechist aides from all three classes voiced their support communally and then Brenda Romero and Nicki Trejo joined me in marking Alexa with the cross. It was a very powerful ritual; we even sang!

**PROCEDURES:** If you witness, suspect or know of child and / or vulnerable adult abuse, YOU MUST FILE A REPORT WITHIN 48 HOURS! Contact Civil Authorities: the Department of Family and Protective Services at 1-800-252-5400 or [www.txabusehotline.org](http://www.txabusehotline.org) or your local police department. If the person is in immediate danger, call 911.

If Church Personnel Is Involved in Alleged Abuse: Step One - Contact Civil Authorities. Step Two - Contact one of the following: Vicki L. Pyatt, LMSW, Coordinator of Pastoral Care and Outreach at (361) 827-7186 or email [pastoralcare@victoriadiocese.org](mailto:pastoralcare@victoriadiocese.org) or call the Diocese at (361) 573-0828 and ask for the Bishop or the Chancellor. Written allegations should be sent to: Office of the Bishop, P. O. Box 4070, Victoria, Texas 77903-4070. Mark your letter "Personal and Confidential."
