If the person is in immediate danger, call 911.

If Church Personnel Is Involved in Alleged Abuse: Step One - Contact Civil Authorities. Step Two - Contact one of the following: Vicki L. Pyatt, LMSW, Coordinator of Pastoral Care and Outreach at (361) 827-7186 or email pastoralcare@victoriadiocese.org or call the Diocese at (361) 573-0828 and ask for the Bishop or the Chancellor. Written allegations should be sent to: Office of the Bishop, P. O. Box 4070, Victoria, Texas 77903-4070. Mark your letter "Personal and Confidential."
