MASS INTENTIONS (\$10.00 stipend)

Q: The priest simultaneously said a Mass intention for the intention for which I gave a stipend and an intention for vocations. Is this allowed?

A: This is allowed. He may celebrate a regularly scheduled parish Mass for which a parishioner has provided an intention (and a stipend), but at the same time he may perhaps have in mind the intention of his elderly mother. In fact, he may have as many intentions as he likes while offering a Mass, so long as he has accepted a stipend for no more than one of them. While on the surface this may seem illogical, keep in mind that the spiritual value of a single Mass is infinite. The intention for which a stipend was offered is not somehow giving short-shrift if the celebrant offers that same Mass for other intentions as well.

As a rule, a priest may only offer one Mass per day, although there are occasions when he may be permitted to offer more than one Mass in a single day ([canon 905.1](#)). (This is why, when St. Frederic has a funeral scheduled, daily Mass is cancelled for the day. Anyone who wants to go to Mass that day is able to attend the funeral.) On Sundays and Holy Days, for example, a priest may celebrate as many as three Masses in one day (and possibly more in areas with a shortage of priests).

From July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 the weekly need is \$3,977.00. This does not include Religious Education, Youth Ministry personnel, which could account for \$16,000 or more, nor does it include the Capital Campaign. However, we are able to keep up financially because of your added contributions to the Fall Festival, Chili Feed and Christmas Bazaar fundraisers. Thank you to all who contribute.

Divine Worship

Dear Parishioners,

Continuing from Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook Chapter 1C states:

Section 1.11.3: "For the sake of uniformity in gestures and bodily postures during one and the same celebration, the faithful should follow the instructions which the deacon, a lay minister or the priest gives, according to what is prescribed in the Missal."⁴⁰

Section 1.11.4: "Liturgical gesture and movement for the sake of inculturation may be used, when appropriate, before or after a Mass or other liturgical rite, though preferably outside the church. However, dance within the liturgy is prohibited."⁴¹

Genuflections and Bows

Section 1.12.1: "A genuflection, made by bending the right knee to the ground, signifies adoration, and therefore it is reserved for the Blessed Sacrament, as well as for the Holy Cross from the solemn adoration during the liturgical celebration on Good Friday until the beginning of the Easter Vigil."⁴²

Section 1.12.2: "During Mass, three genuflections are made by the priest celebrant: namely, after the showing of the host, after the showing of the chalice, and before Holy Communion.⁴³ Concelebrants bow as the celebrant makes the first two of these genuflections, and genuflect individually as they prepare to communicate."⁴³
