THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

- I. I am the Lord, your God, you shall not have strange gods before Me.
- II. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- III. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.
- IV. Honor your Father and your Mother.
- V. You shall not kill.
- VI. You shall not commit adultery.
- VII. You shall not steal.
- VIII. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- IX. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- X. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

WHAT IS THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE?

For those sins committed after Baptism, a person is <u>reconciled with</u> God and with the Church through the Sacrament of Penance. (CCC, 984-985)

WHAT IS SIN?

Sin is any thought, word, desire, or action that destroys or damages our union with God.

HOW MANY KINDS OF SIN ARE THERE?

There are two kinds of personal sin (actual sin that we ourselves freely commit) – mortal and venial.

WHAT IS VENIAL SIN?

Personal sin that weakens but does not kill our relationship with God.

WHAT IS MORTAL SIN?

Mortal sin is a serious violation of God's law. Personal sin that totally rejects God and alienates one from Him, causing a loss of love and sanctifying grace.

WHY GO TO CONFESSION? THE GOSPEL OF SAINT JOHN 20:23 STATES:

²³Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Act of Contrition

My God, I'm sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against You whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend with your help to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Amen.

Genuflections and Bows:

- All who pass before the Most Blessed Sacrament (Jesus in the Tabernacle or Monstrance) genuflect (bending the right knee to the ground) as a sign of Adoration.
- A bow of the head is made when the three <u>Divine Persons</u> are named together (as in the Glory Be), and at the <u>names of Jesus</u>, the <u>Blessed Virgin Mary</u> and of the <u>Saint</u> in whose honor the Mass is being celebrated as a sign of reverence and honor.
- A bow of the body (a profound bow) to the Altar is made during the Creed at the words: and by the Holy Spirit was Incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

THE REAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST IN THE EUCHARIST

The Mass is a true sacrifice. The sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross is offered in the Holy Eucharist in an unbloody and sacramental way. It is a memorial (past, present and future).

WHAT IS THE HOLY EUCHARIST?



The Holy Eucharist is the Sacrament in which Jesus Christ is really and physically present in body, blood, soul and divinity, under the appearances of bread & wine.


