



*Children must know the following basic prayers **BEFORE** entering the Sacramental Preparation Classes for Reconciliation and First Holy Communion (Students will be evaluated at Registration):*

Sign of the Cross

In the Name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and the Holy Spirit, Amen.



With your right hand:

To your forehead say:

In the Name of the Father,

*To your abdomen say: **and of the Son,**
From left shoulder to right shoulder say:*

and the Holy Spirit, Put hands
together in prayer and say: **Amen.**

Glory be to the Father, and
to the Son, and to the Holy
Spirit, as it was in the
beginning, is now, and ever
shall be, world without end.
Amen.



The Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the
Lord is with thee. Blessed are
you among women, and
blessed is the fruit of your
womb, Jesus. Holy Mary,
Mother of God, pray for us
sinners now and at the hour of
our death. Amen.
