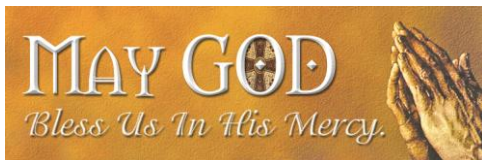
PLEASE DON'T PARK ALONG THE CHURCH
