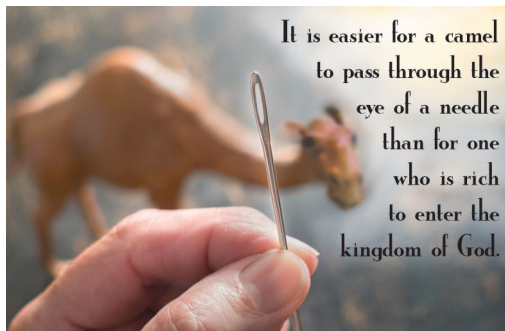

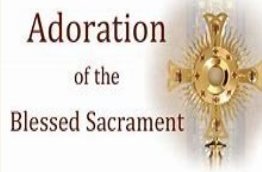


As Nolan Catholic High School prepares to honor the brave men and women who have served our country, we would
