**REFLECTION**

***THE FEAST OF PENTECOST***

After the death of Jesus, his disciples went into hiding in the Upper Room. All 120 of them were huddled together wondering what their next move will be. Then to their surprise, Jesus is standing among them. He tells them that he will send them the Holy Spirit to be their advocate, to help them in their living out of the Gospel.

On that first Pentecost they heard a strong wind and flames of fire and the Holy Spirit came upon them empowering them to go forth courageously and witness to the Risen Christ. What a change had come over them!

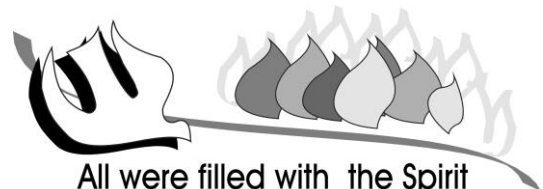
It happened that there were many people from all over the Roman Empire present in Jerusalem that day, because it was a Jewish feast – a harvest feast – and despite their different languages, they could hear the message of the disciples in their own tongue. Such was the effect of this outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

The truth is that the Holy Spirit is the most important person in our lives. During the week as we show our love for others, for members of our families, for the people we work with, for those in need, we will be guided by the Holy Spirit. There are many times in my ministry when I turn to the Holy Spirit to make the right decision, or to say the right thing, or to give the right advice to someone. It's so easy for us to run out of steam, or we think we can do it ourselves. We quickly realize that we need all the help we can get.

The role of the Holy Spirit is to remind us of all that Jesus said and did, especially as we reach out in love and compassion to those in need. Long ago, St. Augustine told his congregation: "If you have love, you have all the gifts of the Holy Spirit. If you do not have love, any other gift or power you may have is worthless." Today, bring the Spirit of Jesus with you wherever you go, and in so doing you will be witnessing to the Risen Christ in your life, like the disciples on that first Pentecost.

## LITURGY PENTECOST SUNDAY

### **First Reading: Acts 2:1-11**

During the Feast of Pentecost, tongues of fire came to rest on the heads of the disciples and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Each disciple began speaking in a different language, and were understood by people from many different regions who were amazed at what they had witnessed.

### **Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13**

Paul explains that we are all members of one body. We have all been baptized in one Spirit and although numerous, we are one through Christ.

### **Gospel: John 20:19-23**

John describes Jesus' first visit to the disciples after his resurrection. He gave them the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive other people or hold them responsible for their actions.

### Camp Auxilium Job Openings for the Summer

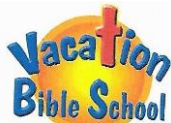


