THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: The celebration of Pentecost brings an end to the Easter Season. We then enter into the season of the Church year known as "Ordinary Time". The name can bring about confusion. It does not mean that nothing special is happening or that this is a slack time in the Church year. The word "ordinary" comes from a word which means "counted". This is counted time. There are two periods of Ordinary Time each year. The first period begins after the Christmas Season and extends to the beginning of Lent. The second period begins after Pentecost and continues until Advent. The weeks of Ordinary Time are counted. Beginning this Sunday, May 29, we will enter into the ninth week of Ordinary Time.

The color for Ordinary Time is green. The liturgical vestments, except for the celebration of special feasts such as Trinity Sunday and the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, is green. I like to think of the green as the one thinks of the green in nature during the spring. The green tells us that the grass and the trees are growing. The green of our liturgical vestments can remind us that this time is a time for spiritual growth. It is a time to allow the mysteries we celebrate during the special seasons, such as Christmas and Easter, to take deeper root in our lives. It is a time to go about the urgent business of walking more closely as disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ. During Ordinary Time, we continue to reflect upon the Word of God and allow that Word to touch our lives more deeply.

Ordinary Time is a great time to deepen our spiritual lives; it is a time to walk more closely with Jesus. May this "Ordinary Time" be for us a time of extraordinary spiritual growth.
