**THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED:** If we truly believe that God sent His Son to save us and to rescue us from sin and all its consequences, then following the Son of God must become the most important goal of our lives. This does not mean that we must neglect or turn away from everything else. It does mean that our involvement with everything else-- family, work, recreation--must be done in such a way that these things do not become more important than remaining in union with Jesus, the Son of God. So often we try to do the opposite. We try to live in such a way that our faith does not infringe on the other parts of our lives. We truly want to gain eternal life, but we do not want to pay a high price to gain that life. This is not what Jesus has taught us. Consider the following bold statement of Jesus. He said that there are two great commandments: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind" and "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:37-39) Additionally, consider the following statement of Jesus: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." (Matthew 16:24) We might think that God is being too demanding, but who else can give us eternal joy, eternal happiness? Is it not wise to deny ourselves now in order to gain something we can never lose? I will end with a quote which has much wisdom: "He is no fool who gives up that which he cannot keep in order to gain that which he cannot lose."
