- ❖ New fire water line sized for future School fire suppression system
- ❖ Up-size existing water line from 1” to 1 1/2”
- ❖ Remove and replace existing clay sewer pipe
- ❖ On-Site storm water treatment is required

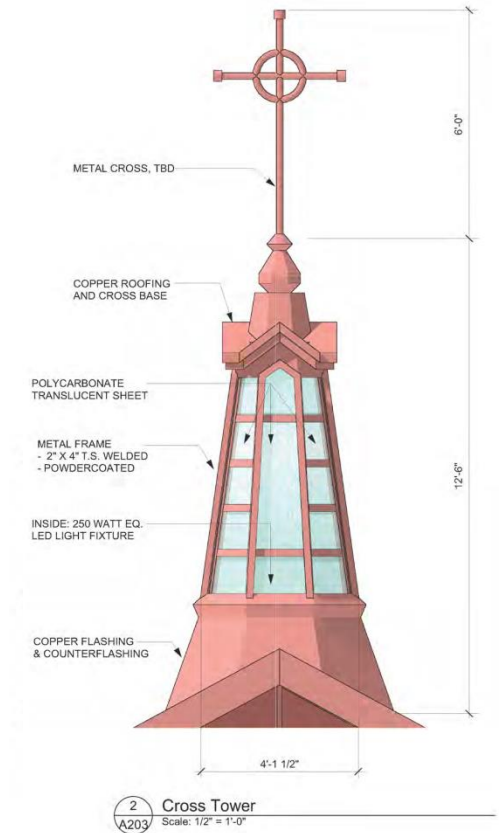
Renewal of our past means renewal of our future...

By investing in the physical structure of St. Paul parish, you can help renew our mission of providing an enhanced space for worship of God, hospitality, and beauty.

What does the Narthex renovation include?

- ❖ Existing church is 5,750 sq. ft. (327 seats)
- ❖ Proposed Narthex expansion will add 1,900 sq. ft.
- ❖ Increased Sanctuary Seating Capacity will add 16-24 seats
- ❖ Increased Balcony Seating Capacity will add 12-15 seats
- ❖ More Handicap Parking Spaces: addition of 6 spaces and 1 Van Accessible space
- ❖ Addition of a metal Cross tower
- ❖ New Reconciliation room
- ❖ 2 new, large ADA compliant restrooms



Proposed Design

Development Budget:

- ❖ Construction Cost. Est.: \$782,732 (+\$36,270 for Cross tower)
- ❖ Design & Engineering Fees: \$84,800
- ❖ Permits & City Fees Est.: \$22,000
- ❖ Contingency 5%: \$40,000
- ❖ Total Project Budget: \$929,532
