Welcome to our parish...we are a community founded in a spirit of unity to serve our God through loving HIM and one another, always!

Dear Parishioners,

Over the last year or so we have invested a lot of time, talent, and treasure into growing our music ministry. I believe we are seeing the fruits of that investment. We had a good foundation and upon that foundation we are in the midst of building a strong, vibrant music ministry for our liturgies. In July of 2015, we brought on Kyle Lorek to work with Jim Markel, Connie Benedum, and our wonderful group of volunteer music ministry members. In April of 2016, we reorganized the responsibilities of the music staff to recognize where their gifts and talents were best used for the whole of the music ministry. Under the leadership of Kyle, who has incredible leadership skills and impeccable vocal skills, accompanied by Jim who has wonderful skills for playing the piano and organ, and with Connie's ability to lead our Bell Choir, I believe we have a great music ministry! In addition, we have our LIFETEEN music ministry for our Sunday 6:00 pm Mass, under the leadership and talent of Ric Koenig and a great group of musicians and vocalists. With the **staff** in place, we set out to create a new and improved space for our music ministry. I believe their new location allows them to be a part of the congregation in a way not possible before that helps them to serve the liturgy. (A few people asked me why their chairs are angled towards the altar and not the congregation. While there is a cantor who faces the congregation at times to help lead us in worship, the primary function of music is praise and worship to God and not performance). Finally, we continue to make improvements to our sound system that allows us to make sure all can hear and actively, consciously participate.



I highlight all of this because I am asking that each and every person give serious consideration to joining our music ministry. We have opportunities for instrumentalists, cantors, and choir members. We now have a traditional SATB (Soprano, Alto, Tenor and Bass) choir that is at the 4:00 pm or 9:00 am Mass each weekend, and we have a contemporary group that is at 11:00 am. This group is a cross between traditional music and contemporary praise and worship music. At the 6:00 pm Mass we have the LIFETEEN music that is all praise and worship. We have a Bell Choir that brings beautiful sounds to our liturgies when they play throughout the year. We have our St. Cecilia Singers that allows children and teens to be in a choir together and learn at a young age the gift of music at Mass. Finally, we have our cantor ministry which is for those with strong voices that can lead us in music at Mass. As you can see there are lots of opportunities. As your pastor and shepherd, I am calling each of you to think about these ministries and consider joining us. All you have to do is contact Kyle at klerek@srweuclid.cc or call him at 216.731.1515. Remembering singing is praying twice! Who couldn't use double prayers? :)

For those of you who are not inclined towards music, perhaps you would consider being an Usher at Mass. We are in the process of revamping how we do this ministry and the ministry of greeter at Mass. We have some great people now, but we need more. At every Mass we need at least eight people to assist with the ministry of greeting and ushering. It is a very simple ministry to volunteer for as you only have to come 15 minutes prior to Mass and stay about 10 minutes afterwards. **Men and women** are welcome to do it, and there are rarely any other additional responsibilities. The ministry of usher and greeter is all about hospitality and helping people to feel welcome and comfortable at Mass. The Scriptures tell us that those who offer hospitality sometimes offer hospitality to Angels:) Please consider this ministry. We need people for all four weekend Masses.
