

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend at the 4:00 pm Mass, we welcome Bishop Roger Gries and the men studying to be permanent deacons for our Diocese. As a step in their journey to become ordained as a deacon, God willing, Bishop Roger will be installing them as acolytes at this Mass. We assure them of our prayers and are so happy they are with us today.

This is also Catholic Charities weekend. We have the opportunity to support the annual appeal for this vital ministry in our community that reaches out and helps so many people! As one of the largest comprehensive health and human services organizations in the region, Catholic Charities, Diocese of Cleveland carries out Christ's healing mission here in Northeast Ohio. Catholic Charities, Diocese of Cleveland delivers more than 150 services at 60 locations to nearly 400,000 people each year – providing help and creating hope for people of every race and religion in each of the eight counties in the Diocese. I really encourage you to be as generous as possible. Our parish has met its goal all seven years since our establishment. We have one of the highest participation rates of the 187 parishes in the Diocese. This is a tribute to all of you and your major commitment to helping the most vulnerable in our community. I am so proud of all of you. And on behalf of the church, THANK YOU!

Speaking of generosity, our SRW Outreach ministry would like to thank you for your generous donations last fall to help keep homeless men warm this winter. We collected 16 coats, 25 hats, 18 pairs of gloves, 4 hoodies, 4 light-weight jackets, 1 vest, 1 pair of shorts, 3 sport coats, 1 pair of pants, 12 pairs of socks, 1 sweatshirt, 4 scarves, and 4 earmuffs. Sometimes the simplest things can make such a difference!

Our Seniors' Ministry will be meeting this Tuesday at 2:00 pm at Gateway Manor (behind Home Depot on 200th Street). I really want to encourage our seniors to attend this gathering. It is a wonderful opportunity to gather as a community. If you know someone who is not able to drive themselves, call them, invite them, and offer to pick them up.

Listed below are scholarships available to SRW students. A Committee comprised of the Principals, Director of Development/Stewardship, two (2) Teachers and the Chair of the Endowment Board or someone designated by the Chair review the applications and make recommendations to the Pastor for awards. Each year our celebration of Catholic Schools' Week begins with a parish Mass at which we distribute \$5,000 in scholarships for Catholic Education.

Congratulations to this year's Scholarship Winners:

The St. William Pastor/Principal Scholarship for \$500 is given to a student in grades K-2 who shows potential leadership skills. This year's **Pastor/Principal Scholarship** is awarded to *Raeagan Kvoriak*.

The St. William Parish Endowment Founder's Scholarship for \$500 is awarded to a student in grades 3-5 who does something unique to show him/herself as someone willing to take a stand and who does not always follow the pack. This year's **Founder's Scholarship** is awarded to *Jacob Ericksen*.

The St. William Parish Endowment Benefactor's Scholarship for \$500 is given to a student in grades 6 - 7 who makes a significant contribution to his/her class and/or school community. This Scholarship is given in honor of Margaret & Frank Kearns, Russell E. Seibert, Edward Paulis, John McGroarty & Carl Baricelli who were memorialized by significant donations to the St. William Parish Endowment that was inherited by Ss. Robert & William Parish in 2010. This year's **Benefactor's Scholarship** is awarded to *Zac Tizzano*.

The Sr. Dorothy Kazel High School Scholarship is awarded to an eighth grader who is a registered and active parishioner of Ss. Robert and William Catholic Parish. The \$500 scholarship is renewable each year of high school, provided the student remains in good standing with his/her high school and participates in the SRW Life Teen Ministry. Sr. Dorothy made the ultimate sacrifice with her life. The scholarship is intended to go to an eighth grader who knows what the word "Sacrifice" means. For the first time in its history, we had a tie for the winner. Congratulations to *Ariel Winfrey* and *Maggie Radachy*.

The Sr. Helen Marie Davidson, OSU, Scholarship, named for Sr. Helen Marie, a teacher at St. Robert School, is being awarded for the third year. A former student has endowed the parish with \$100,000 to fund this scholarship. Each year four \$500 scholarships will be given to 2 boys and 2 girls entering 7th or 8th grade. Winners are to be Catholics who regularly attend Mass, are involved in extra-curricular activities, and who are able to articulate the value of a Catholic education. The winners this year are: *Mary Radachy, Josie DiDona, Eric Sito, and Zac Tizzano*.

The Edward J. Czyzycki Annual Service Award is a \$1,000 annual scholarship given to a 7th grade student who exhibits the outstanding practice of the Catholic Faith through charitable deeds. *Josie DiDona* has been chosen by her teachers for this honor.
