The Seminary has assigned Mike Feldtz here as a 5th year seminarian. Mike entered the seminary after a number of years in the insurance industry. The men who do not enter from college do "summer internships" instead of an internship year so that they can complete major seminary in four years instead of five. Mike will start his summer internship here on May 22. Then, when school resumes in the fall, he will go back to classes during the week and then spend weekends and Mondays here starting in the winter. After his ordination as a transitional deacon in October, he will be a deacon here until his priesthood ordination. He will be ordained a priest in May 2018.

Alex Spenic who just completed his first year at St. Mary Seminary will be here for the summer. He will live and work here. His focus will be office work, youth ministry, homebound ministry and helping our staff improve their use of technology.

Ryan Arto and Jim Winings will also live here. They are both entering St. Mary Seminary in the fall as first year men. Ryan is a graduate of Borromeo Seminary, and Jim completed pre-Theology requirements. Ryan will work maintenance, and Jim is working for COAR.

### IS THE JUSTICE SYSTEM JUST?

In an ongoing effort to present pertinent information to communities throughout Lake County, Saint Mary Magdalene Parish will be hosting a forum on Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 pm in the Church. The forum will focus on what happens at each stage of the justice system when a person is arrested, charged, and convicted of a criminal offense. A panel consisting of a Lake County Police Chief, Lake County Prosecutor Charles E. Coulson, and Lake County Common Pleas Judge John P. O'Donnell will discuss the way the justice system in Lake County actually works. The panel strongly encourages questions from the audience. In past forums held in other communities, the inquiries have focused on whether members of minority classes and those with lower socio-economic status are fairly treated.
