The Mass offering is \$10 per Mass.

International Overdose Awareness Day

On Saturday, August 31st is International Overdose Awareness Day. This is the day that we remember those that passed due to an overdose and unfortunately in our community there are a lot of people that die in such an unfortunate way.

A candlelight vigil will take place at Fall River City Hall at 7pm followed by a candlelight procession to St. Anne's Church for prayer in memory of those lost to overdose. The church bells will toll for local victims of the opioid epidemic.
