Stewardship Reflection



The answer is to have our faith and our finances working together, by seeking first God's Kingdom, putting God first in how we share, save and spend our wealth, and then trusting God. Living this way frees us from worrying. Trusting in God's providence is also one way we strengthen our relationship with Him — "all these things will be given to you as well". (Matthew 6:3)".
