Hall Rental: To rent either the St. Charles Parish Hall or the St. Pius Hall, please call the office.

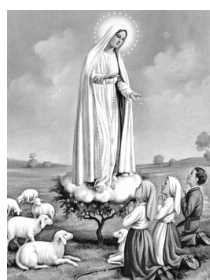
