### ***Let us love....in deed and truth. (1 John 3:18)***

In today's second reading, John offers us solid guidance on how to "remain" in God's love. He tells us that one of the secrets to this is to listen to the movements of our hearts. That's because the heart, or the conscience, is the place where the Holy Spirit speaks to us most intimately. So what does this mean for us? It means that if the Holy Spirit is at work in our hearts, then we should take it seriously when we sense a tug in our hearts. We should pay attention to the movements of our hearts, because it may well be that the Spirit is trying to help us make the right decisions and draw closer to the Lord.

So try to remain in God's love today. Try to listen to the movements of your heart. And try to put into practice whatever you think God is asking of you.
