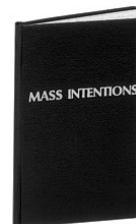

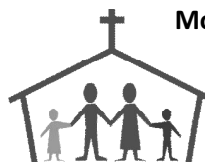

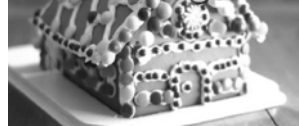

St. Patrick Parish Applauds!!

On October 15, 1928, Cardinal Dougherty of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia came to the City of Pottsville, by train, to dedicate a brand new school building. At exactly 3:30 pm, the building located at 112 7th Street, began its historical tenure as Pottsville Catholic High School and St. Patrick Parish Elementary School. The building currently operates as a school and is the home of Assumption B.V.M. On October 15, 2018, 90 years later, Msgr. O'Connor rededicated and blessed the Assumption B.V.M. building. Assumption B.V.M. School is a Great Pearl in our community. It is a caring community of faith, rooted in the tradition and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church and focuses on academic excellence. We are thrilled that 90 years later the building still stands as a holy example of Catholicism, and is a blessing to all of the hundreds of children who walked the halls and learned in the classrooms!
