From the Pastor: Father Damian or St. Damian of Molokai is known for his work among the lepers in Hawaii. During the last year of his life, he was cared for by Sr. Marianne Cope of the Sisters of St. Francis of Syracuse, New York. Sr. Marianne was born in Heppenheim, Germany in 1838 and was brought to this country a year later when her family relocated to Utica, New York. At age 24, she pursued a religious vocation entering the convent which led to her involvement with health care and hospital administration in Central New York. In 1883 she and six other sisters from her order sailed for Hawaii in response to King Kalākaua of Hawaii's request for assistance for those afflicted with leprosy. She remained there until her death in 1918 at age 80.

In 1992, a 14 year old girl was diagnosed with ovarian cancer. During the course of her treatment, she suffered a cardiac arrest and later began multi-organ failure. Prayers seeking Sr. Marianne's intercession were made and within a week, the girl's conditions began to reverse. In 1995, a woman was diagnosed with pancreatitis and was also in multi-organ failure. Sr. Marianne's intercession was sought and her condition began to reverse. In both of these cases, the patient's eventual recovery was accepted as

medically inexplicable and attributable to the intercession of Sr. Marianne. She was canonized in 2012 and is now known as St. Marianne Cope. Her feast day is January 23.
