

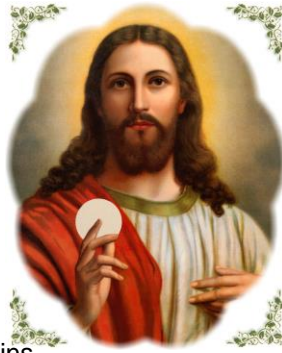
Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the Pastor: St. Peter Canisius, S.J. was a Dutch Jesuit Priest who lived from 1521 until 1597. He was known for his sermons and writings promoting devotion to the Blessed Mother. He is credited with formulating the petition added to the **Hail Mary: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners.** On Wednesday, the Church celebrated Mary's Assumption into Heaven. St. Peter Canisius wrote the following about the Assumption

The Church frequently and reverently keeps feast days dedicated to the Mother of God, realizing that it is a work pleasing to God and worthy of the faithful if many feasts, with fixed dates and public ceremonies, are celebrated in honor of the most blessed of all the blessed in heaven, the Mother of our Lord and God. Among all these feasts which have been celebrated so devotedly for so many years, even unto the present day, the Feast of the Assumption is considered the greatest and holds chief place. Indeed there was no happier or more joyful day for Mary, if we duly consider the happiness of both body and soul granted to her on that day. Then especially, as never before, her spirit, soul and body rejoiced wondrously in the living God and she could rightfully say: *He has regarded the lowliness of His handmaiden; for behold, all generations shall call me blessed; for He that is mighty has magnified me.*

In Conewago Chapel history, while visiting here, Bishop Kenrick of Philadelphia determined that the addition of the transept and

sanctuary and the art work added to the walls and ceiling had resulted in substantially a new church. He consecrated the present church on August 15, 1851. Two days later, he confirmed 170 here. Two days after that, he was named Archbishop of Baltimore.
