Pastors Column: The WWII Chaplains Foundation was founded by a priest from the Diocese of Harrisburg Chaplain (Colonel) Robert F Berger, USA (Ret.). The Foundation is supporting the cause for sainthood of Chaplain Ignatius Maternowski (OFM, Conv). A native of South Hadley, Mass., Chaplain Maternowski was ordained in 1938 and entered the US Army in 1942. He served with the 82nd Airborne Division and on D-Day, he parachuted with his troops behind enemy lines. A few hours later, he was killed by a German sniper after negotiating with his German counterpart to

establish a common aid station for the wounded. He was the only US chaplain killed on D-Day and was awarded the Purple Heart posthumously. Information about the Foundation and Fr. Maternowski's cause may be found in the vestibule.
