Lead them straight and true; give strength to their arms, stoutness to their hearts, steadfastness in their faith.

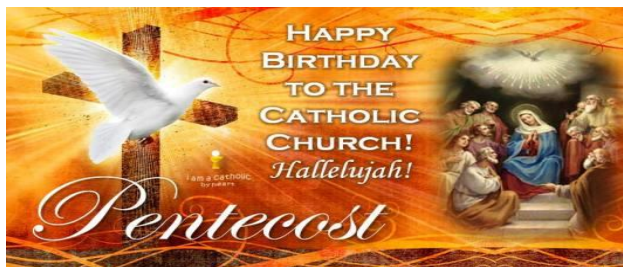
They will need Thy blessings. Their road will be long and hard. For the enemy is strong...
