Each weekend, a number of people habitually
park in unmarked areas (like next to Our Lady's
Garden) causing **GRAVE PROBLEMS.** The
lines are drawn quite intentionally to maximize
traffic flow, to create drop-off points for children
and the elderly, and to ensure that vehicles are
not blocked in. At times emergency service
personnel and health care professionals have to
dash from Mass due to emergency calls. In many
cases they have been blocked. This is a **VERY**
serious issue.

If you do not find a parking spot in the
lot, then norms of courtesy would suggest that
you look for a space on one of the side streets.
Spaces are generally available on the Adee
Avenue side of the rectory. Let us not sacrifice
the comfort and safety of others for a momentary
convenience. Together, we can make our parish
hospitable to all who come!
