### **Abortion is not health care**

Abortion advocates speak as if abortion is health care, a procedure that is morally and emotionally equivalent to surgically removing one's tonsils or appendix. It is often conveyed as so morally neutral that only a few religious outliers find it objectionable. Yet in reality, the vast majority, over 85%, of OB/GYNs, coming from many faiths or no faith refuse to be associated with or perform an abortion. In addition, according to the pro-abortion Guttmacher Institute, 86% of hospitals were not involved in abortion. Finally, even *Roe* acknowledges that abortion is unlike other procedures performed by a health professional and that unborn children deserve some protection. Abortion is not health care and we do a disservice to women and health care providers to pretend it is.

"[T]he right of privacy, however based, is broad enough to cover the abortion decision; that *the right, nonetheless, is not absolute and is subject to some limitations; and that at some point the state interests as to protection of health, medical standards, and prenatal life, become dominant* . . . . The pregnant woman cannot be isolated in her privacy. She carries an embryo and, later, a fetus . . . . *The situation therefore is inherently different* from [other situations where the Court has recognized a constitutional right of privacy, such as] marital intimacy, or bedroom possession of obscene material, or marriage, or procreation, or education." 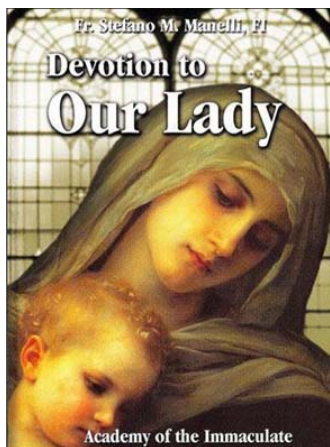

### REFLECTION FROM CATHERINE DOHERTY

#### The Second Commandment

*Thou shalt not take  
the name of the Lord thy God in vain.*

This commandment is a continuation of the first, in which God makes it known that he desires our worship and our adoration. In this second one he commands us to be filled with veneration and respect for his divine name. He commands us to honor it, and to refrain from using it in vain.

It is not fear alone that should keep us from profaning the name of God. It is love that should seal our lips, and love, again, that should open them to use his holy name as a blessing, a joy, a word spoken with all the reverence and respect our minds, hearts, and souls are capable of.

Let us stop for a moment...stop and *really* think about what is asked of us! Incredible as it may seem, God asks us, his creatures, to love him. That he should demand from us adoration is understandable. But love? The very thought should make one happy, with happiness that is beyond all understanding!

### ALL-NIGHT VIGIL

Beginning this month the monthly All-Night Vigil will be suspended permanently. This change is due to a variety of reasons (lack of servers for the early morning Saturday Mass, the on-going problem of the church being used as a flophouse for the night with eating/drinking and a mess being left for the sacristan on Saturday morning, etc.) Over a year ago a proposal was made that order is to be maintained in the church throughout the night or the Vigil would be suspended all together. There was an improvement for a while but now it is back to where it was a year ago. This is no one's fault but the reality of being very near Times Square in the heart of the City of Manhattan. Sleeping/snoring, lounging, eating, drinking and talking are all disrespectful behaviors toward the Blessed Sacrament and is not to be tolerated under any circumstances.

On the first Monday of every month, our 12:15pm Mass is celebrated in honor of these children and for the comfort of their families. We pray that you will find peace in knowing that your child(ren) will be remembered at the Shrine and honored by all who pray here.

We will inscribe the names of babies who have died before and at birth in our Book of Life, and as always, we invite you to visit the Shrine if you are in New York City.
