LIVING OUR FAITH

What's the difference between a Christian and someone who simply goes to church? One answer might be the power of the Holy Spirit. Without reflection, we may be lulled into thinking that the point of religion is to go to church regularly, or to "be good," Or at the very least, to feel guilty when we are "bad." We skim the surface of religion when we think this way. Being a disciple of Jesus is more challenging and more exciting than trying not to break too many commandments and rules.

Let's consider the experience of the first disciples. They listened to Jesus, day after day. They followed him around, stayed out of trouble, prayed when he prayed (they sometimes slept through the praying part:)) yet nothing really changed for them or made much of an impact on their real lives until the Holy Spirit showed up. Suddenly they grew backbones, showed a lion's share of courage, spoke out on what they believed and then lived what they spoke. And their testimony had power and people were transformed by what they heard and saw. It puts mere church going to shame doesn't it?
