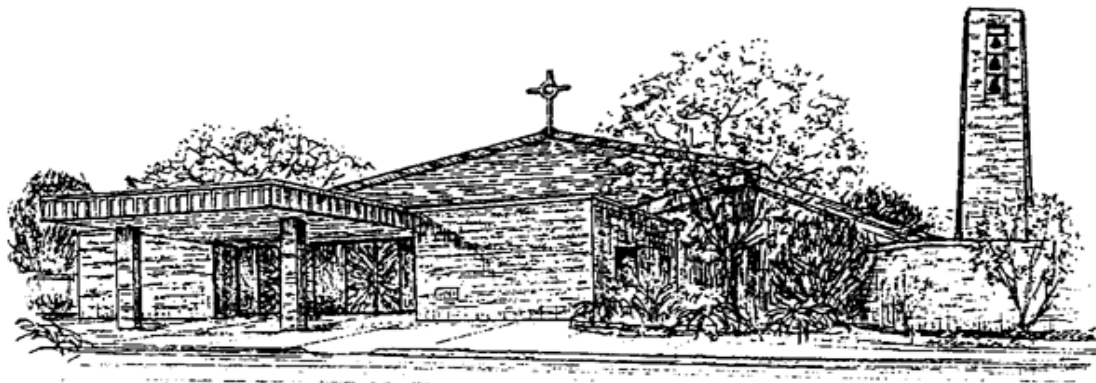

**2018 Sharing God's Blessings:  
The Archbishop's Annual Appeal**

Through your generosity, we have surpassed (in pledges) our 2018 AAA goal. The goal was \$95,837. We have in pledges of \$105,070 with 262 families participating.

**Now the work of the parish is to make sure those pledges are honored.** To date, we have received \$90,200 toward those pledges. **There is a balance to be collected of \$14,870.**

If all pledges are fulfilled, then Most Blessed Sacrament Parish will receive 62% of all funds received over our assigned goal. At this point, that would mean MBS would receive a rebate check from the Archdiocese of Newark in the amount of \$5,724. We have included this amount as anticipated income in our fiscal 2019 budget. Thank you for fulfilling your pledges!

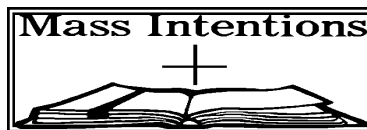

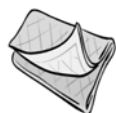
