Content (30 points)	Introduction includes the student's name, name of the agencies worked with over the past 4 years, when the hours were completed, and a brief description of the type of work their projects involved.	3	
	The student clearly identifies their CSP projects as a practice of a corporal/spiritual works of mercy. This work of mercy is stated and defined by the student in the presentation.	3	
	The student explains how the corporal/spiritual works of mercy are practically implemented in their Christian Service work throughout 4 years..	7	
	The student clearly identifies and defines which virtues they put into action during their service work.	3	
	Practical examples of virtue-in-action are given.	7	
	The student reflects on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Challenges of the service work and how the student overcame/addressed these. ● The positive contribution that was made for those served ● What was learned/gained from this experience 	7	
Presentation (20 points)	The presentation is between 10-15 minutes (this does not include the time for Q&A after the student's presentation)	5
