Stand in front of a group of kids and say these words: "I need a volunteer." Every hand will go up.

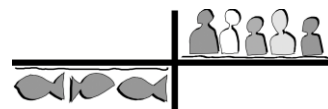

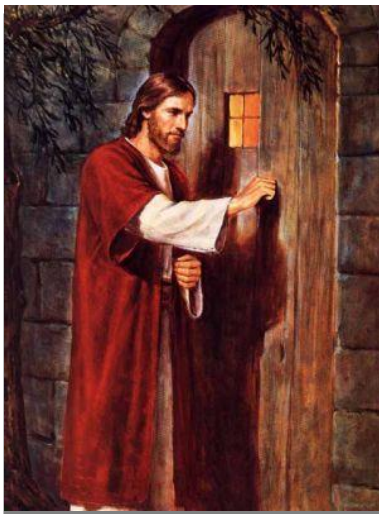

Information Meeting on Thursday - February 28 A Pilgrimage in 2020: The Oberammergau Passion Play ...

is a world-famous presentation of Our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection staged every 10 years by the entire town of Oberammergau in Bavaria, Germany. As the "Black Plague" was ravaging Europe and hundreds of people were dying, sometimes an entire town would be wiped out, the people of the town of Oberammergau made a vow to God that they would show their gratitude to him by presenting a passion-play if their town was spared. And it was! The first Passion Play was performed in 1634.

Information Evening on Thursday - February 28 at 7 PM at St. Philip School Library, 618 Putnam Pike in Greenville. The Library is located on the left side of the Church behind the fenced-in playground and is clearly marked "Library".
