

FROM FR. RAY:

The second collection next weekend will be taken up for our annual Diocesan Missionary Projects Appeal. This year the Diocese of Ogdensburg has assigned the parishes of St. Augustine and St. Mary's to provide financial support to The Heralds of Good News of the Mother Theresa Province.

This missionary society, founded in India, serves throughout the world to carry out the society's mission to promote vocations to the priesthood, train seminarians, and supply dedicated priests where they are needed. One of those areas in need of priests has been the Diocese of Ogdensburg, and the Heralds of Good News have answered the call.

Today, two priests from this missionary society have traveled 9,000 miles to serve the faithful here - Fr. Justin Thomas who currently serves as parochial vicar for the Cathedral of St. Mary and Notre Dame Church in Ogdensburg and Father Tojo Chacko who currently serves as parochial vicar for the churches of Sacred Heart, St. Mary and St. Joseph in Massena and the church of St. Lawrence in Louisville.

Priests of The Heralds of Good News are given the opportunity to work in different parts of the world and are prepared well during the period of the seminary formation to adapt themselves to the places where they are sent.

This weekend we are privileged in having Father Tojo Chacko speak specifically about the great work of The Heralds of the Good News and as mentioned, next weekend's second collection will provide financial support for the good and necessary work given by all who serve The Heralds of the Good News.

COST OF CEMETERY GRAVE LOT CHANGE

The current cost of a grave at St. Augustine's Cemetery is \$250 (\$75.00 of which goes to perpetual care). At our recent Cemetery Committee Meeting a review of the Cemetery finances revealed a need to increase our revenue. The Committee Members agreed to increase the cost of purchasing a grave. Until September 1, 2016 the current cost of a grave will remain the same. After September 1, 2016 the cost of a grave will be \$500 (\$200 of which will go to perpetual care).

The current cost of a grave at St. Mary's Cemetery is \$250.00 (\$75.00 of which goes to perpetual care). At our recent Cemetery Committee Meeting it was decided to increase the cost of purchasing a grave. Until September 1, 2016 the current cost of a grave will remain the same. After September 1, 2016 the cost of a grave will be \$400 (\$100 of which will go to perpetual care).

A grave is for one full body burial or may be used for one full body burial and one cremation burial or may be used for 2 cremation burials. Anyone who would like to purchase a grave before the price increase is asked to call Dianne Russell at the parish office (483-6674) for a purchase of a St. Augustine grave or Sharon Manson at 529-6251 for a purchase of a St. Mary grave.






