First Communion Scheduled:

May Crowning Rosary And Mass:

Our annual May Crowning Mass will be held on Monday, May 22nd. All are invited to meet at the school flagpole at 6:45 p.m. for a Rosary and flower procession to Our Lady's Altar (please bring flowers for the procession). Mass will begin immediately following the procession. Following Mass, there will be a **potluck reception** in the Parish Hall. Please bring a dish to share—items may be dropped off in the Hall prior to the Rosary and procession.

Change To Parish Sick List:

Currently, we have maintained our Sick List under two designations—"Indefinitely" and "Four Weeks". As time has gone on, 95% of the names on this list have now fallen under the "Indefinite" heading. We've also found that people put on this list remain there, even when they are in recovery. In order to more effectively manage this list of names, we will begin accepting names for a duration of four weeks, allowing for one additional four-week extension. Our goal is to list the names of those on a shorter, rather than a longer-term basis. We will begin this process for the weekend of May 27-28 and will continue forward from that point.
