The celebration of First Communion is a significant event in the life of our parish.

The Easter Season includes readings from the Acts of the Apostles. The first part of the Acts of the Apostles centers on the person of St. Peter and the second part on the person of St. Paul.

Both parts are accounts of the life of the Early Church. Among the many themes developed in the Acts of the Apostles is that of fulfilling the command of the Lord that the Gospel be proclaimed throughout the world.

Where the Gospel was proclaimed, some came to believe in our Lord Jesus. This belief led them to be baptized. The Acts of the Apostles recounts that the Apostles laid hands on those who were baptized to bestow upon them the sacrament of confirmation, the gift of the Holy Spirit. The baptized and confirmed were also given the sacrament of the Eucharist to nourish then with the True Bread from heaven, the very Body and Blood of Christ the Lord.

Twenty centuries later, the Church continues to enable others to come to belief and to be sustained in that belief with the sacraments.

Our celebration of the children's First Communion last week firmly sustains them in the same sacraments, continuing the Tradition. The celebration of First Communion should be seen as important to the whole community, not just the children and their families.

As you read through the names of the recipients of First Communion, please remember them in your prayers so that they may continue to be immersed in the faith.
