**National Holiday:** Wednesday, July 4, is Independence Day. The office will be closed in observance of the federal holiday. The Mass on Wednesday will be at 9 a.m. There will be no earlier Mass that day.

**First Saturday:** Saturday, July 7, is the First Saturday of July. There will be a Mass at 8 a.m. The Saturday evening Mass will be at 4 as usual.

**Centennial News:** The bishops of this region meeting in July 1917 recommended to the Apostolic Delegate, the representative of the Pope in this country, that a new diocese be established in the western most part of the Archdiocese of New Orleans, that is, from the Atchafalaya River to the Sabine River. The bishops projected that the Catholic population in the proposed diocese would be around 150,000.

**Fete Dieu de Vermilion:** The Blessed Sacrament will be brought by boat from Abbeville to Lafayette on August 15. The day will begin with Mass in French at St. Mary Magdalen, Abbeville, at 8 a.m. and will end with vespers and Mass at the Cathedral in Lafayette at 5 p.m. The procession will pause for devotions at Wawees in Milton at 11:35 a.m. and at Ruffinno's in River Ranch at 1:40 p.m. The procession will then leave from Beaver Park at 3:45 p.m. and end at the Cathedral.
