The Sacrament of Baptism

We welcome new life into the Church through the sacramental sign of Baptism which is celebrated **every Sunday of the month at 1:00pm** with the exception of Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. We encourage parents who wish to have their child baptized to call the Parish Secretary, Michele O'Toole, at 609-702-1848 ext. 301 or stop in and pick up a Baptism packet.

Once the Baptismal Preparation class is attended, the form completed and the Godparent Eligibility Certificates are turned in then a date for your child's Baptism will be set.

Baptismal Preparation

Catholic Godparents are required to complete an Eligibility Certificate and have the certificates signed by the pastor of the parish where they are currently registered and practicing their faith.

We offer a Baptismal Prep Class for parents as a way of preparing them for their child's journey of faith. Classes are scheduled for the first Wednesday of every month at 7:30pm. Please contact the Parish Secretary to register.

Sacramental Sponsorship Letter

This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation. To receive this form the following requirements must be met:

- If married, be in a valid marriage according to the laws of the Catholic Church.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Completed the Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation
- Be a registered, active participant of a Parish.

The Sacrament of Marriage

Couples wishing to celebrate and consecrate their love in the Sacrament of Marriage are asked to call the Parish Secretary, Michele O'Toole at 609-702-1848 ext. 301.

Arrangements are to be made with the Pastor a year in advance of the requested date. At least one person should be a registered member of the parish. All couples are required to attend preparation sessions.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Any Catholic who is seriously ill, advanced in age, or who feels the need for the comforting presence of the Church's sacramental prayer life may be anointed. Please contact the Parish Office at 609-702-1848 ext. 301 during office hours. In the case of an emergency, please call and follow the instructions listed on our telephone message.

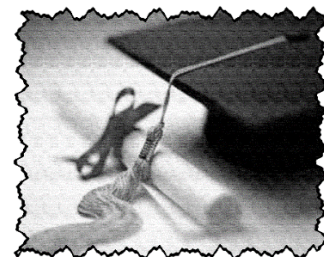
Honoring Our Graduates June 24th at 11:30am Mass

EVENING BIBLE STUDY

Our fall Bible study will be different from past ones. Instead of a commentary and study guide, we'll be using a single text book, John Kaltner's *Reading the Old Testament Anew: Biblical Perspectives on Today's Issues*. It is 256 pages of text, consisting of an introduction and six chapters. Each runs about 35-40 pages in length. The book provides an overview of the Old Testament's perspectives on a number of topics that are of interest to many of its modern readers. It does this by considering biblical passages that are related to each of the themes and by explaining how scholars have attempted to understand and interpret those texts. The topics treated are creation, covenant, liberation, the human condition, the other, and social justice. The introduction presents some general background information on the OT – what it is, its contents, the contexts from which it emerged and to which it responded, and the various ways it has been read and interpreted. There are discussion questions in the margins throughout the text and further reflection questions at the end of each chapter.

We will not be following previous formats, however, as there simply is too much material to read each week prior to class. Instead, participants in this Bible study will have to obtain a copy of the book ahead of time – preferably by the end of June – so as to be able to read it through in advance of the beginning of classes and then just reviewing what has been studied before each weekly class.

The book sells for just under \$30 if purchased directly from the publisher, Anselm Academic. If we qualify for a group rate, the publisher will give us a 15% discount and we're hoping for reduction or waiver of shipping and handling charges. Most likely, however, even with these savings the total purchase price will be around \$30 if we deal directly with the publisher. Competitive prices could be available through on-line suppliers.

The Circle Project by Deacon Jim Casa
 We live in modern times...very, modern times and this is why The Circle is going to be an important consideration this summer. Essentially, any pretense to maintaining personal privacy was abandoned long ago when people signed on to free hi-tech services. Realistically, did any of the US Senators who listened to Mark Zuckerberg's mea culpa a few weeks ago, think that Facebook, which charges nothing for its services to users, was simply providing a public service for free? Of course not. Simply put, social media is 'big business' and it is here to stay. Nevertheless, as we have seen, social media comes with a warning label and this is what brings us to the latest Sacred Heart 'read the book - see the movie' summer project which will be, Dave Eggers' powerful novel, *The Circle*. Partly adventure story, partly romance, partly speculative fiction, *The Circle* is surely a modern cautionary tale about the hi-tech trends that have come to affect our lives - and not always for the better. It is the perfect book to read for this summer, entertaining and meaningful. The story: When young Mae Holland, our story's hero, is hired for the CIRCLE, the world's most powerful internet company (Facebook, Google, Amazon, YouTube, Messenger, WeChat, Instagram, Tumblr, Twitter, Skype, LinkedIn, Snapchat, Pinterest, et. al., together, pale in comparison to the power and scope of CIRCLE - consider that), she feels she has been given a wonderful opportunity...the job of a lifetime. However, what appears on the surface may not be what it is all cracked up to be. What begins as the captivating story of one woman's ambition and idealism soon becomes a heart-racing novel of suspense, raising questions about political responsibility, privacy, human rights, history, crime prevention, morality, democracy and the limits of human knowledge. The themes which *The Circle* addresses are comprehensive and quite important for our times. So you are invited to take part in this summer's project. Simply, begin your reading of Dave Egger's *The Circle*. Then, we will gather on September 14 to watch the film adaptation of *The Circle* (starring Academy Award winning actor, Tom Hanks and Emma Watson from Harry Potter fame). A word of consideration, *The Circle* was published in 2013 and as such, is a very modern novel that features a few adult situation moments in the story and has some random use of strong language. Don't let that dissuade you. Please don't. *The Circle* is an challenging modern parable; its message is most urgent as we move along in this 21st Century. Look for updates in Bulletins throughout the summer.
