Parish Registration

Our Parish family warmly welcomes new members. Please register at your earliest convenience by stopping by the Parish House during the office hours.

The Sacrament of Baptism

We welcome new life into the Church through the sacramental sign of Baptism which is celebrated **every Sunday of the month at 1:00pm** with the exception of Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. We encourage parents who wish to have their child baptized to call the Parish Secretary, Michele O'Toole, at 609-702-1848 ext. 301 or stop in and pick up a Baptism packet.

Once the Baptismal Preparation class is attended, the form completed and the Godparent Eligibility Certificates are turned in then a date for your child's Baptism will be set.

Baptismal Preparation

Catholic Godparents are required to complete an Eligibility Certificate and have the certificates signed by the pastor of the parish where they are currently registered and practicing their faith.

We offer a Baptismal Prep Class for parents as a way of preparing them for their child's journey of faith. Classes are scheduled for the first Wednesday of every month at 7:30pm. Please contact the Parish Secretary to register.

Sacramental Sponsorship Letter

This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation. To receive this form the following requirements must be met:

- If married, be in a valid marriage according to the laws of the Catholic Church.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Completed the Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation
- Be a registered, active participant of a Parish.

The Sacrament of Marriage

Couples wishing to celebrate and consecrate their love in the Sacrament of Marriage are asked to call the Parish Secretary, Michele O'Toole at 609-702-1848 ext. 301.

Arrangements are to be made with the Pastor a year in advance of the requested date. At least one person should be a registered member of the parish. All couples are required to attend preparation sessions.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Any Catholic who is seriously ill, advanced in age, or who feels the need for the comforting presence of the Church's sacramental prayer life may be anointed. Please contact the Parish Office at 609-702-1848 ext. 301 during office hours. In the case of an emergency, please call and follow the instructions listed on our telephone message.

John Is His Name

Today we commemorate the birth of John the Baptist.

John is the prophet of hope.

He was born, lived, and died to prepare the way for the Good News. This great forerunner of the Lord was a beacon calling for all to turn to Christ and live.

It is not until John's circumcision eight days after his birth that Zechariah, upon writing John's name, is able to speak. The literal meaning of the Hebrew name, Yohanan, is "Yahweh has shown favor."

You found John worthy of a martyr's death, his last and greatest act of witness to your Son."

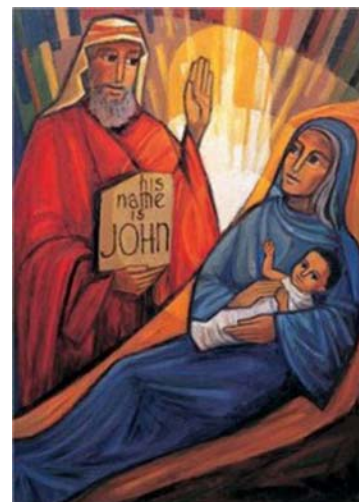

As the summer gets a bit warmer, get comfortable with a nice outdoor chair, a cold beverage and a copy of *The Circle* (novel by Dave Eggers) for the Sacred Heart summer 'read the book - see the movie' project. This novel is a high tech page turner - partly adventure story, partly romance, partly speculative fiction, *The Circle* is surely a modern cautionary tale about the hi-tech trends that have come to affect our lives.

In each of these Circle Project updates, we will look at what the reviewers have said about this very important story.

From Flavorwire;

"With *The Circle*, Eggers has given us everything...When you put down the book and go to check your email, you might just realize that we are living the fiction...[*The Circle*] takes place before a fall that we might really be approaching and it's this compelling sense of impending, unpredictable doom that makes this work of fiction feel very real, and very necessary."

The morality of this timely story is profound. So, simply, begin your reading of Dave Egger's *The Circle*. Then, we will gather on September 14 to watch the film adaptation of *The Circle* (starring Academy Award winning actor, Tom Hanks and Emma Watson from Harry Potter fame). A word of consideration, *The Circle* was published in 2013 and as such, is a very modern novel that features a few adult situation moments in the story and has some random use of strong language. Don't let that dissuade you. Please don't.

Religious Education News

Summer Program 2018

Hello Sacred Heart Parishioners,
While another school year is winding down and families are shifting to the more relaxed and leisurely season of summer, we here in the Religious Education Office at Sacred Heart aren't slowing down – we are getting ready for our 2018-2019 Summer Religious Education Program and our Fall Program, too!

Most of us are accustomed to the traditional version of what used to be called (and truthfully often still is) "CCD" – a class one night each week where children learn about and grow in their Catholic faith. Anyone who has been in our parking lot on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings during the school year probably knows that we do still offer this standard program! However as modern family life has become somewhat more complex, the Church is continually looking for new and creative ways to bring children into faith formation programs in ways that, rather than competing with secular demands, work harmoniously with the realities of family life without compromising the quality of the religious education that the children are receiving. For many parishes, this has meant adding a summer intensive program as an option for their families. In our Summer Program here at Sacred Heart, children attend class for three hours daily for two consecutive weeks (this year we begin on July 16). Since classes begin at 8 am, we are able to attend daily Mass during the two weeks, which is one of the major benefits of the Summer Program. (And each year, I receive numerous compliments about the children's attentiveness and behavior from our regular daily Mass attenders!) Because we are also in class when Sacred Heart School is not in session, there is an allowance for additional creativity in our use of the classroom space, in everything from décor to lesson plans. With a relatively quiet summer campus, we also have more time and occasion to take "field trips" to the St. Vincent De Paul pantry, the Adoration Chapel, and even just out front on the parish grounds to learn about God while enjoying His beautiful creation.

While our summer option works for many families, and has become very popular in our parish, our traditional, weekly Fall Program also offers flexibility for many families as they can

choose whether their children attend classes on Tuesdays or Wednesdays. There are also highlights of our Fall Program that we don't have in the summer. Because children attend classes each week throughout the year in our Fall Program, we are able to celebrate the liturgical seasons as we experience them. Our Thanksgiving prayer services, Advent Family Lessons, and Stations of the Cross services help to enhance their experiences and draw connections between what they are learning and our faith traditions and worship. The weekly format also allows children time to absorb what they are learning as they continue to grow in their faith so that each week can build on the next. We are really blessed at Sacred Heart to be able to offer both of these Religious Education options for our children, and at the heart of both programs are our wonderful volunteers, especially our catechists, the main classroom teachers. I am continually amazed and inspired by their dedication, and realized shortly after taking this position that working with them was one of the most beautiful blessings of my job. Father John and I are always grateful for and look forward to our end-of-the-year celebration dinner in the parish house each May, because we have the opportunity to honor our catechists for the generosity they demonstrate through the sharing of their gifts and time with our children and their families.

We continually welcome new volunteers to join us and become a part of this wonderful group! We are always seeking new catechists especially, and ask our parishioners here at Sacred Heart to prayerfully consider becoming a part of this ministry, which is so vital to the faith formation of the next generation of Catholics. We are offering a class, called 'The Art of Catechesis,' for those who are interested in becoming catechists or catechist aides on July 7th at 9 am.
