Adoration will follow the 9 am Mass and last until the Procession at 3 pm. Bring your family and join the clergy of our Region in representing our parish in this public display of our faith in Jesus' Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. There will be hymns and rosary as the Procession goes from the church, through St. Martin of Tours cemetery, and ends with Scripture Readings, Homily (by Fr. Hopper) and Benediction. Bring your lawn chair! It would be great to see our parish represented and carrying banners and if our 1<sup>st</sup> Communicants dressed up and brought their families too.
