# CELEBRATING THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY AT ST. CYRIL OF ALEXANDRIA PARISH

## The Sacrament of Matrimony:

The Catholic community believes a marriage is sacred. It is the union of a man and woman who freely enter into a matrimonial covenant of love with each other in Christ.

The teachings of Christ make it clear that marriage is a partnership for life, Christ which is ordered to the good of the spouses, and the procreation and education of children. This means that throughout this marriage each spouse not only promises to love the other until death, but to also look out for the welfare of the other spiritually, mentally, and physically.

They are to mirror Jesus' love as they go about their daily lives. It is the couple's duty as parents to raise their children to live as Jesus asks us to live, and to be witnesses to the work of the Holy Spirit in the world. Marriage is a sacrament when both spouses are baptized, whether Catholic or not.

**From the beginning it is intended to be a faithful, permanent and valid commitment for one's whole life, until the death of one of the spouses.**

## Here at St. Cyril's:

- ◆ Couples may go thru the marriage preparation parish and celebrate their wedding here.
- ◆ Couples may go thru the marriage preparation and marry at another Catholic parish.
- ◆ Couples may go thru the marriage preparation at another Catholic parish and marry here.

## Where to start:

- ◆ Please allow a minimum of nine months to complete your marriage preparation process.
- ◆ Before you reserve a venue for your reception or set a date, stop by the office or the hospitality desk during business hours and pick up a marriage packet.
- ◆ Fill out the registration form and turn it into office with your registration fee. Once you registration form is turned in, the marriage coordinator will contact you to set an appointment for an initial pre-marital interview.

## Requirements:

- ◆ Attend a series of meetings with the marriage director.
- ◆ Attend a one day weekend retreat.
- ◆ Bring in a recently dated baptismal certificate.
- ◆ Bring your First communion and confirmation certificates if applicable. (You do not need to have your first communion and confirmation to marry in the church).
- ◆ Marriage license. (If you are already married civilly, bring a copy of your marriage license).
- ◆ If you have been married before whether civilly, Protestant, Orthodox, Jewish, non-Christian, Catholic or common law, please inform the marriage director.
- ◆ The marriage formation coordinator may request additional documentation based on your situation.
