

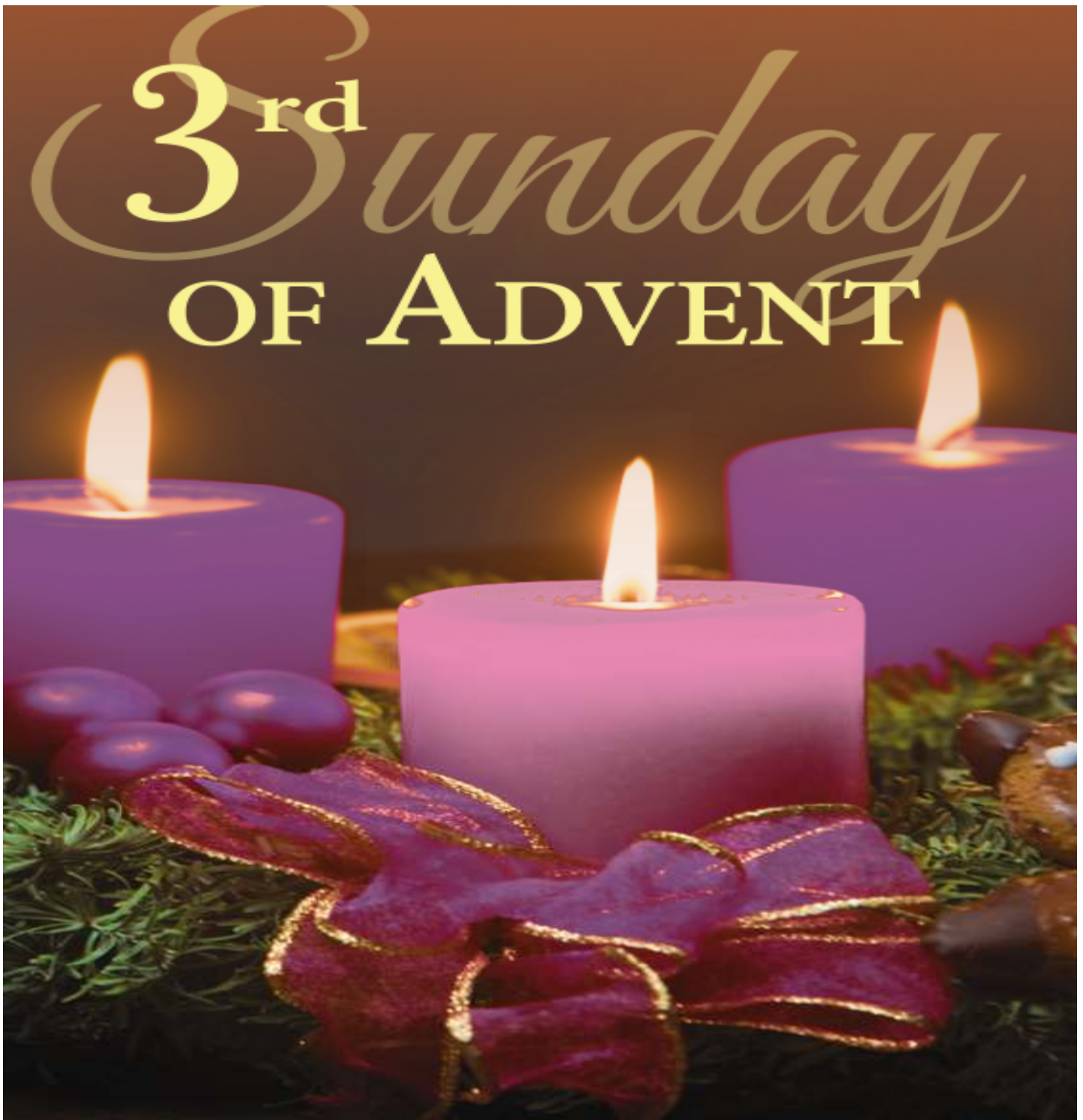

- **Rejoice in the Lord always; for indeed, the Lord is near.**

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The final days of Religious Education in 2016 are upon us! The last day of Wednesday Religious Education classes is December 14th. The last day of Sunday classes for Religious Education will take place on December 18th. Please note that **Wednesday classes** will not resume until **January 18th, 2017**. **Sunday classes** resume on **January 29th, 2017**. The reason for the late start is twofold: (1) It is preferable to give the students about two weeks to adjust to resuming classes and/or a new class schedule and (2) the Religious Education program follows the Moore County School calendar. When there are no classes on a Friday or a Monday, Sunday classes are typically cancelled to account for those families that travel and are away. As always, be sure to follow the Religious Education Calendar that has been handed out and is available on our website.
