The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* reminds us that "The initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful."

The work of initiation is really the work of the entire parish community.

There is an RCIA Teaching Team that provides the bulk of the instruction and guidance of those wishing to join the Church.

Perhaps the more influential role is that of the Godparent (for those seeking Baptism and Confirmation) or Sponsor (for those already Baptized, who wish to join the Catholic Church and those who are already Catholic and are now seeking Confirmation).
