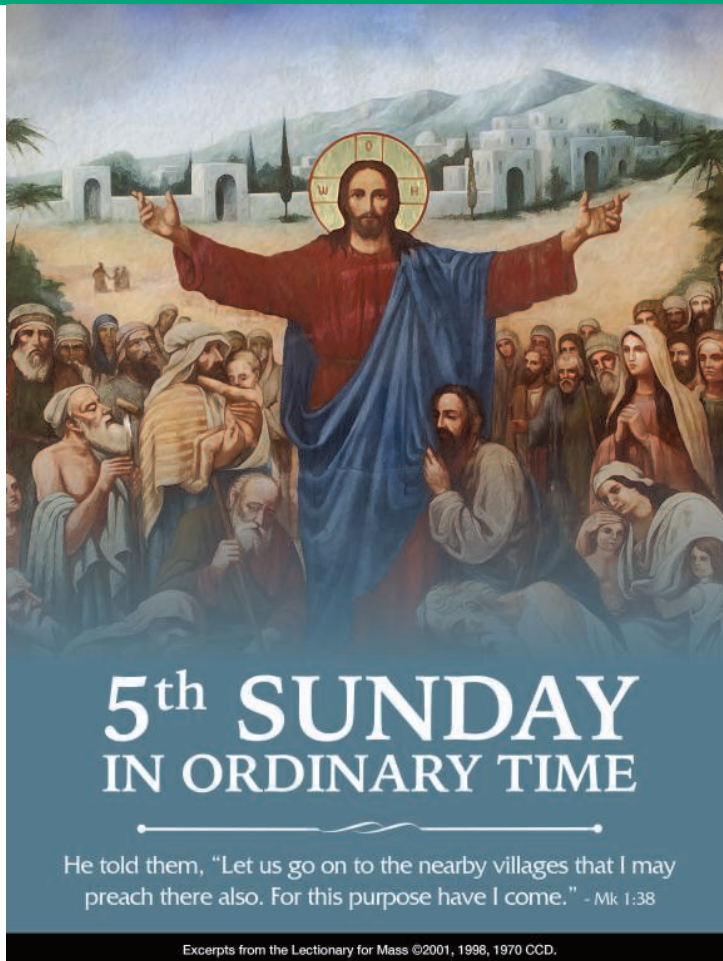

Illness and Participation in the Mass

The Diocese of Madison's Offices have received a number of questions regarding participation in the Mass during the flu season. We hope that the following points are useful:

1. While Catholics are obligated to attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, a serious reason may cause you to miss. Being sick is a serious reason for being excused from the obligation to attend Mass. If you have the flu or some other serious and/or contagious illness, please stay home. (Another common serious reason is severe weather.)
2. If you feel you have a cold or if you have a compromised immune system, please don't shake hands with others during the sign of peace. You may smile and say, "The peace of the Lord be with you."

Thursday Morning Adult Faith Sharing

Adults interested in exploring the Sunday Gospel readings throughout the Season of Lent thru Easter Time are invited to join the Thursday Morning Faith Sharing group as we read, study, and share the Gospel readings for Year B. We will meet weekly (except for Thursday, March 15) following the 8:00 am Mass at Saint Patrick (8:35-9:35 am) in the parish hall. Cost for study materials is \$10 per person. We begin the Thursday after Ash Wednesday, February 15. Study materials are from the Augustine Institute and are part of the FORMED parish subscription. While weekly participation forges the habit of scripture reflection and prayer, please know that you are welcome whenever you can come! The hour will include a brief video segment, reading the Gospel, prayer, reflection and faith sharing.

Ash Wednesday/Valentine's Day

This year, the largely secular celebration of Valentine's Day (February 14) coincides with Ash Wednesday, and some have wondered whether a dispensation from the obligations to fast and abstain from meat might be given. Catholics throughout the world recognize Ash Wednesday as the solemn beginning of a period of penance and prayerful reflection on the Lord Jesus' sacrificial suffering, as is evident by the large number of churchgoers on this day.

In view of the significance of Ash Wednesday, the obligations of fasting and abstinence must naturally be the priority for all Catholics. Valentine's Day can appropriately be celebrated the Tuesday evening before Ash Wednesday, which also happens to be Mardi Gras, a traditionally festive time before beginning our annual Lenten observance.
